JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTER PROJECT FACT SHEET



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Juvenile Justice Center (JJC) project provides for the construction of a modern facility that continues to protect the public and provide a safe and secure environment for youth that are placed in the center. The new facility, when complete, will meet the demands of a growing population by including: a 64-bed capacity; improved safety, security, and efficiency; and, the enhanced integration of the legal and administrative services needed to effectively address and manage processes and procedures associated with juvenile detention. The JJC will be constructed at the existing Juvenile Detention Center (JDC) site location in two phases over approximately three years to avoid disruption to operations.


CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE PHASE 1

Description:

Maintain operations at existing facility; construct secure intake and 64-bed detention portions of facility

Time Frame:

Spring 2024 – Summer/Fall 2025




CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE PHASE 2

Description:

Transition operations to Phase 1 portion of facility; demolish existing facility; construct courtroom and support offices.

Time Frame:

Summer/Fall 2025 -Fall/Winter 2026



BENEFITS

The new facility is a proactive effort to build a facility with the bed capacity to serve our County. The current JDC has aging infrastructure and an inefficient design — both problems are solved with the new facility. Placing the entirety of the juvenile justice system at the new JJC will improve staff efficiency, eliminating the need to drive to and from the County Courthouse.
